### SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES 2014

- 1) There are two scholarships of \$1000 each during a year (awarded to two applicants).
- 2) Deadline: May 31st
- 3) All scholarship applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee of the Polish Club of Denver.
- 4) To be eligible for a scholarship, the applicant, or his/her parent/s must be active member(s) of the Polish Club of Denver, Inc. for at least three (3) consecutive years.
- 5) After the receipt of the scholarship the recipient or her/his parents will be obligated to volunteer help on two of the Polish Club of Denver events within one year from the date the scholarship is awarded.
- 6) Applicant (or his parents) must be a citizen or a permanent resident of the United States of America, and must be a resident of Colorado.
- 7) Consideration will be given only to applicants who successfully completed first year of a college level studies.
- 8) Criteria used in evaluating candidates applications:
  - a. Scholastic average
  - b. Involvement with the Polish Club of Denver
  - c. Community service
- 9) The scholarship committee may request a personal interview.
- 10) In order to be considered for the Polish Club of Denver's scholarship please complete the following items:
  - a. Completed Polish Club of Denver application to include all necessary information to evaluate your request.
  - b. Verification of attending an accredited college/university (transcripts, etc.)
  - c. Verification of scholastic average (test scores, transcripts, report card, etc.) From last two (2) semesters.
  - d. Copy of Colorado ID/Driving License and proof of legal residency in the US (Green Card or US Passport).
  - e. A letter of recommendation from an officer of one Polonian organization or community organization (Optional).
  - f. A letter of intent must be written by applicant stating his/her interest and thoughts regarding his/her Polish-American heritage and describing community service she/he performed and active involvement with the Polish community.
- 11) Any false or misleading information may disqualify the applicant from participation in the scholarship program.
- 12) All scholarship awards will be forwarded directly to the accredited college/university which the applicant attends.
- 13) All information submitted on the application is considered confidential and will be discussed only within the scholarship committee. After the scholarship committee makes their decision as to the winner of the award, all application documents will be sealed and kept for two (7) years. After this time, they all will be destroyed by the then chairman of the scholarship committee and a member of the board of directors.
- 14) All applicants will be notified by email and mail shortly after the committee reaches their decision and notifies the Board of Directors the Polish Club of Denver.
- 15) The Polish Club of Denver, Inc. scholarship recipient will be announced at the Club's general membership meeting as determined by the Board of Directors.
